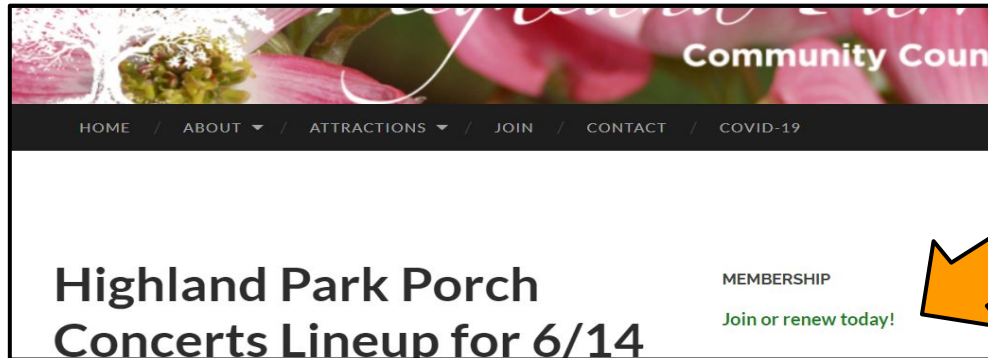

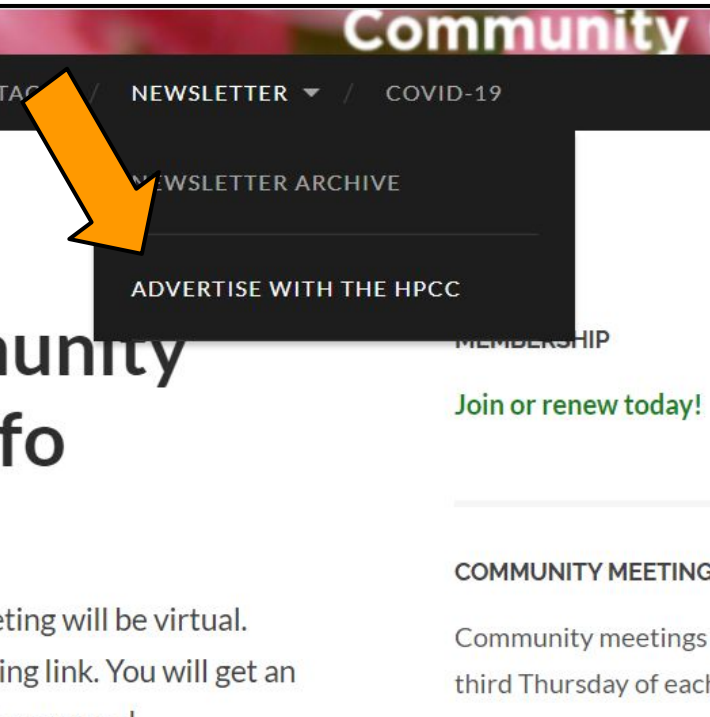
HPCC Membership Stats

Project Overview

- Current playground built by the community in 1991
 - Originally intended to last 20 years - sustained further by stewardship by HPCC and City
 - Fully funded to be redesigned and rebuilt
 - New design but same emphasis on a unique, creative playspace covering current playground's large footprint
 - Facilitated by a public community design process this fall with actual construction starting next spring
